<b>Acceptance of Disease</b>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Patient is in the initial phase of acceptance of their disease and its treatment
<input type="checkbox"/>	Patient has accepted his/her disease and its treatment
<input type="checkbox"/>	Insufficient data available to assess the patient's acceptance of their disease

<b>Support (family and community)</b>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Patient has good family and/or other support system
<input type="checkbox"/>	Patient has no family, no relative, no support from friends or community. Has no community services
<input type="checkbox"/>	Patient has family, relative, or friends. Has some support, however it is inconsistent. May have community services
<input type="checkbox"/>	Patient utilizes community and health care support services

<b>Compliance</b>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Patient has a history of noncompliance with medications, treatments, diet, keeping medical appointments, etc.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Patient can follow some of the prescribed therapy, occasionally does not follow regimen
<input type="checkbox"/>	Patient is compliant. Follows instructions of prescribed treatment regimens. Very rarely misses treatments or appointments
<input type="checkbox"/>	Pertinent information not available or not relevant to this situation

<b>Image</b>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Patient needs to gain confidence in their ability to perform self care tasks
<input type="checkbox"/>	Patient is confident in their ability to perform self care tasks

<b>Participates in Learning Process</b>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Patient does not appear to be listening, easily distracted, shows no interest in knowing about their disease or treatment
<input type="checkbox"/>	Patient appears interested, responds with non-verbal and verbal interactions, follows conversation and asks appropriate questions

<b>Concentration and Cognition</b>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Patient is able to concentrate for short periods of time before becoming disinterested or restless
<input type="checkbox"/>	Patient can concentrate on a subject for 20 minutes at a time
<input type="checkbox"/>	Patient is unable to concentrate for short intervals and frequently does not comprehend or retain what has been presented
<input type="checkbox"/>	Patient is well dialyzed, comfortable, able to concentrate and comprehend material presented

<b>Vision</b>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Patient is legally blind or can identify faces and objects but cannot read printed materials. Vision cannot be corrected with glasses
<input type="checkbox"/>	Patient can read large type without glasses
<input type="checkbox"/>	Patient can read normal print with glasses
